Top Education Projects in the last 5 months

€14m School Development, St Patrick's Junior & Senior Schools, Blanchardstown, Dublin 15







Main Contractor Glasgiven Contracts, Co. Dublin has commenced work on the development of a new conjoined school for existing Junior and Senior Primary schools.

The building is two storey and approx. 6025 m2 in area. Facilities include 36 classrooms, 2 general purpose halls, breakfast club and ancillary facilities. Works also include landscaping, play areas, car parking and site works. Phased construction on operational school site.

Works are expected to take 24 months to complete.

€6.4m School Development, Scoil Mhuire, Stranorlar, Co. Donegal

Boyle Construction has commenced work on a €6.4m School Development at Scoil Mhuire, Stranorlar, Co. Donegal.

Works to include the construction of a new 24 classroom primary school of approximately 4,000 sq.m., together with associated external works and site services on a greenfield site at Mill Brae, Stranorlar, Co. Donegal.

Works are expected to take in the region of 16 months to complete.

An Bord Pleanála upheld Cork City Council's decision to grant planning permission to Christian Brothers College for a development on a site comprising Sidney Hill, Wellington Road & St. Patrick's Hill, Cork.

The development will consist of: the construction of a new 5 storey school house (comprising 8 no. classrooms, library, digital suite, 4 no. offices, toilets, stores, plant accommodation, school hall and associated facilities, in a single structure measuring 2435m2 (gross floor area) and an overall height of 21.1m the site for this building has frontage onto St. Patrick's Hill, Cork.

€12.8m School Development in Enfield, Co. Meath

€18m School Development Beach Road, Sandymount,Dublin 4

A planning application was submitted to Meath County Council on 04/09/2020 by the Department Of Education & Skills for a development which will consist of a part three storey, part two storey post primary school, including a PE hall, 4 classroom special educational needs unit and all ancillary site works at.

The proposed project also incorporates associated staff car parking, delivery access, drop off areas, pedestrian access, bicycle lane, construction of 6 no. external ball courts, landscaping, connection to public services, esb sub-station and all associated siteworks

A decision to grant planning permission was issued by Dublin City Council on 25/08/2020 to Department of Education & Skills for a protected structure.

The development which will comprise a new educational campus, delivered on a phased basis, will include the phased demolition/removal of the existing educational/institutional buildings on the site including the two storey Roslyn College, the link element between the two storey rear extension to Roslyn Park House and Roslyn College, the two storey Sandymount Park House and the existing temporary accommodation to the rear of Sandymount Park House.


